Durban (Zulu: eThekwini, from itheku meaning 'bay') is the largest city in the of KwaZulu-Natal and the third largest city in the country It forms part of the eThekwini metropolitan municipality. Durban is famous for being the busiest port in South Africa. It is also seen as one of the major centres of tourism because of the city's warm subtropical climate and extensive beaches. The municipality, which includes neighbouring towns, has a population of almost 4.5 million, making the combined municipality the biggest city on the east coast of the African continent. The metropolitan land area of 2,292 square kilometres (885 sq mi) is comparatively larger than other South African cities, resulting in a somewhat lower population density of 1,513 /km² (3,920 /sq mi)

This vintage shows an intriguing mélange of aromas and flavours - passion fruit and citrus as well as melon and pink grapefruit aromas with just a hint of green grass and figs.

Aromas of gooseberries, lemon zest and grassy nuances. Subtle tropical aromas with hints of passion fruit and citrus.

Sophie T'blanche

Elegant, complex and finely balanced is how many would describe Sophie Te'blanche, the most famous woman never to exist, and also a nickname in South Africa for "Sauvignon Blanc".



Chardonnay

The king of white wines is made very differently now to how it was made 15 years ago. Wooded or unwooded, it is arguably the most interesting and tasty of white wines. Give it a go from this magic selection below!

Meerlust

R500

Complex, appealing nose with quince, citrus and floral notes developing into lemon cream, oatmeal and marzipan richness, full bodied & generous, but still balanced by crisp acidity.

Hamilton Russell

R550

A tight, minerally wine with complexity. Prominent pear and lime fruit aromas and flavours are brought beautifully into focus by a tight line of bright natural acid. An elegant, yet textured and intense wine with a strong personality of both place and vintage. Estate Wine of Origin Hemel-en-Aarde Valley.

Mulderbosch

R 215

A 5* wine – need I say more!

An un oaked Chardonnay with lip smacking freshness. One bottle won't be enough!

Glen Carlou

R220

This wine rewards with rich, round fruity flavours, harmoniously balanced with well integrated oak.

Anura

Pinot Noir

The king of Burgundy. This is a fascinatingly seductive wine which deserves to be treated with honour at the table. Pinot Noir tends to behave like a spoilt princess in the vineyard and can be shy in the glass compared to some more “in your face” styles. Stay clear of spicy dishes.

Hamilton Russell

R 500

Tightness, tannin line and elevated length, balance the richness and generosity. Soft and "sweet" but shows hints of that alluring savoury "primal" character along with a dark, spicy, complex primary fruit perfume. Estate Wine of Origin

Haute Cabrierre unwooded

R 240

Taylor made for our Durban summers – unique and innovative, she loves company. Serve chilled.



Cabernet Sauvignon

The king of red wine cultivars. It can be made in various styles from full powerful wines with upfront fruit, to medium bodied wines with well integrated fruit and supple tannins.

Often used in red blends and a wine which complements red meat perfectly.

Guardian Peak Lapa

R 450

This larger than life Cab will impress and seduce you. Take up the challenge!

Waterford

R 330

Aromas of cedar wood, cigarbox and cassis.

Meinert

R 210

Elegant, classic and perfectly balanced, much like its owner!

Protea

R 120

A wine that will surprise you with its grip and balance and a steel at the price!

Glass R30

Warwick First Lady

R155

The nose reveals lots of red berries & sweet blackcurrant, complemented by vanilla & chocolate oak & pleasant herbal undertones. The smooth, ripe, round tannins make this wine easy to drink while still retaining a full body.

Shiraz

Better known as Syrah outside South Africa and is seen by many, as the great hope for South African wine. It is the most exotic of reds, with immense concentration and complexity. It has nuances of fruit, oak, spice and leather.

Luddite

R 400

This wine shows plums and spice first, followed by a richness of natural fruit sweetness. All these flavours are backed by fine tannins and balanced wood use.

Raka Biography

R 220

Spicy aromas with hints of chocolate, coffee and black fruit is forthcoming on the bouquet, with dried plum and pepper flavours. Complete structure and a full bodied wine with good balance between the tannins and acidity leaving a lingering after taste.

Fairview

R 180

Intense red in the glass. Plummy fruit on the nose with a hint of sweet raspberry and splashes of opulent spice. The palate is complex and layered, revealing further fruit flavours and rich mouthfeel. Spice lingers on the finish. The wine shows excellent potential

Merlot



A rich and fragrant wine with very accessible berry character and roundness which appeals to the new red wine drinker. It is the top selling red wine in KwaZulu Natal.

Quoin Rock

R 175

A complex array of rich berry fruit and plums with chocolatey undertones is evident on the palate. This wine is full with a delicate tannin structure, fine acidity and a long finish.

Anura

R 210

Loads of ripe blackberry, red berry and blackcurrant flavours, hints of herbal and violet aromas are folded in layers of dark chocolate. This full-bodied, well-balanced wine has lingering flavours of berries and mint.

Guardian Peak

R 140

Smoothly curvaceous, friendly and likeable. Don't delay, drink today!

Glass R35

Pinotage

This cultivar originated in South Africa as a cross between Pinot Noir and Hermitage. It produces a medium to full bodied red wine with a highly distinctive, fruity character. Great strides have been made in the making of Pinotage and properly made, a wine to be respected. This can be seen by increasing interest shown worldwide in South African Pinotage.

Diemersfontein

R 210

The Original coffee/chocolate Pinotage that has taken the market by storm never disappoints. Rich mocha flavours with wafts of caramelised banana.

DewaldtHeyns Weathered Hands

R 140

Dominant red fruit with hints of banana and liquorice, the oak is wellintegrated and compliments the palate. Soft, supple tannins with an enticing long finish.

Bordeaux Style Red Blends



A classic Bordeaux Blend needs to be made up of 2 or more of the following varietals, namely, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Petit Verdot and Malbec. They are elegant wines that benefit from ageing and are to be enjoyed with hearty meals.

Meerlust Rubicon

R 600

South Africa's iconic blend exhibiting complexity and depth, typical of all the Meerlust wines.

Fusion Z

R 380

Undeniably one of South Africa's best red blends. This wine expresses very delicate undertones of orange zest. A second wave of flavours announces prunes, cinnamon and sweet red fruit.

Provenance Rooi

R 240

Not as simple as the name implies. This wine is succulent & fruity with perfectly matched tannins. Reward yourself.

R 155

Accessible, well structured and eminently affordable.\

Rhône Style Blends

The wines of the Rhone tend to be more rich and spicy in general and are made up traditionally of Shiraz, Grenache, Mourvedre and Viognier. These unusual wines are gaining in popularity and are worth exploring.

The Chocolate Block

R 400

Spicy notes on the nose supported by ripe plum, black fruit & violet aromas. The wine has a grippy acidity & well integrated tannins, a well textured & rounded mouth feel ending in a long, elegant & succulent finish.

Fairview Caldera

R 250

Bright ruby appearance with soft white pepper spice alongside gently smoked blackberry fruit. Accessible tannins and integrated acidity make for a classically styled wine.

Spier Creative Block 3

R 240

The wine shows fragrant aromas of violets, mulberry, sweet fruits, spice & toast. The rich & creamy palate delivers forward mulberry flavours with subtle vanilla & chocolate & a lingering aftertaste

Cape Blends



There are two schools of thought on this one, but currently to constitute a Cape blend, the wine should have 30% Pinotage in the blend.

Meinert Synchronicity **R 550**

This “proprietor`s blend” is a big rich wine that despite its power retains a fine elegant core.

Warwick Three Cape Ladies **R 280**

This vintage displays lots of prune & berry compote aromas as well as peppermint chocolate & sandalwood.

Beyerskloof Synergy **R 180**

The blend may vary but the wine is always in perfect synergy! Fast developing a following.

Anura **R 120**

Rich aromas of spice and plum. An elegantly balanced wine with overtones of oak, **Glass R30**
black pepper and lingering coffee flavours.

Dessert Wines

Glen Carlou The Welder **R 180**

This wine is made in a fresher style which is not overtly sweet with a **Glass R20**
balanced acidity intense bouquet of pineapples, apricots & orange peel with hints of vanilla & spice.

La BriPineau de Laborie **R 180**

A fortified , sweet wine made from pinotage grapes. **Glass R20**
