

# Red Wines

## Merlot

### Durbanville Hills

44/173

Dazzling with flavour. Strong mint on the nose, intense berry in the mouth. Subtle oak lingers long after the last sip.

## Pinotage

### Beyerskloof

35/140

Medium bodied, dark ruby red in colour. Bundles of black cherry and plums with a hint of oak, subtle tannins with a well integrated and balanced acidity.

## Shiraz

### Zonnebloem

40/158

Deep red with ruby tinges. Lots of berry fruit with prunes followed by smokehouse aromas.

## Cabernet Sauvignon

### Durbanville Hills

44/176

On the palate the grape and wood tannins are well balanced with a strawberry and raspberry finish.

### Nederburg 5600

115

A ripe style of Cabernet with lots of fleshy, juicy, berried fruit and hints of chocolate and mint.

## Pinot Noir

### Haute Cabriere Unwooded

183

Small berries and thin skins create this ruby-red wine. Enjoy Chilled.

## Blended Reds

### Kanonkop Kadette

193

A blend of 50% plus Pinotage, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Cabernet Franc. A Cape classic.

### Durbanville Hills Bastion

145

Full-bodied Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz boasting a soft and velvety mouthfeel and a lingering fruit aftertaste.

## White Wines

### Sauvignon Blanc

#### **Durbanville Hills** 39/147

Boasting flavours of tropical fruit and green peppers leading up to a crisp finish and a full mouthfeel.

#### **Klein Constantia KC** 142

Fresh acidity compliments the tropical style, with flavours of sweet melon, fig and lemongrass coming through.

#### **Paul Cluver**

Clean and fresh with expressive granadilla, elderberry and black currant characteristics. 167

#### **Springfield – Life from Stone**

Brilliant greenish in appearance, this complex wine shows full ripe red peppers and passion fruit. 51/195

### Chenin Blanc

#### **Nederberg 5600 Chenin** 29/110

Well-balanced with abundant aromas of white peach, guava and apricots.

#### **Cederberg** 41/156

Grown at high altitude ensures a long cool season yielding a vigorously fresh crisp style.

### Chardonnay

#### **Louisvale unwooded** 33/126

A crisp, fresh new age Chardonnay with a hint of lime and litchi.

#### **Fat Bastard** 38/145

Full, rich and ripe with some pretty serious oak treatment. Lives up to its name.

#### **Tokara** 146

Fresh and crisp. Lemon zest aromas, toasted brioche and upfront notes of ripe yellow fruits and a hint of toasted oak.

## Blanc de Noir, Rosé, Blends & Others

#### **Jordan Chameleon Rosé** 136

A brand new dry, French-styled rosé made in traditional fashion. Great as a versatile lunchtime wine.

#### **Boschendal Blanc de Noir** 31/118

Lovely salmon coloured wine boasting a complex palate of peach and pineapple flavours.

#### **Buitenverwachting Buiten Blanc** 120

This Sauvignon Blanc based blend will go well with any seafood and salads.

#### **Haute Cabriere Chardonnay/Pinot Noir** 179
