Stanford Hills Estate Wines

Stanford is a relatively new wine production area which is showing tremendous potential. The proximity of Stanford Hills Estate to the coast ensures cool sea breezes during the hotter months, allowing the grapes to gently ripen. Owner Peter Kastner believes that great wine is produced in the vineyard, and credits the wonderful soil and climate of the region for the quality of the Estate wines. All grapes used are produced on the farm itself and picked by hand to ensure only the best quality grapes are used for annual wine production.

Sauvignon Blanc 2022 Bottle R165 / Glass R50

This fresh and lively Sauvignon Blanc shows a blend of tropical fruit, kiwi and a saline finish. 10% was fermented on skins and this lends texture, stone fruit and peach while the white limestone clay soils lend tension and a savoury-saline finish

Shiraz Rosé 2022 Bottle R 165 / Glass R 50

Pale and fresh, our 2022 Rosé is best enjoyed chilled in both temperature and temperament. Deep red fruit flavours of dark red cherries and currants are prominent with great acidity to back it up.

Reserve Shiraz 2020 Bottle R 215 / Glass R 60

This is a beautiful example of cool climate Shiraz. The nose is rich and full of flavour with dense tannins, hints of tobacco and white pepper that accentuate dark red fruit of ripe plum and dark cherries, blue berries with a long cocoa finish.

Jacksons Pinotage 2018 Bottle R 215 / Glass R 60

Our Flagship Pinotage vineyards are planted on perhaps the coolest terroir for this grape in the country. Our twenty-three year old, unirrigated vines are planted on a South Easterly slope right under the Kleinrivier Mountain. This, coupled with winds coming from the icy Atlantic Ocean brings out the delicate Pinot noir parentage of South Africa's very own cultivar.

Our Jacksons Pinotage is a prime example of cool climate Pinotage. After three years in bottle, this wine is still showing lively fruit flavours of red cherries, tomato leaf and plum, followed by subtle tertiary characters of tobacco and dried fig.

Veldfire

Our Veldfire range is based around our incredible terroir for South Africa's own grape variety: Pinotage was crossed in 1921 by Professor Perold at Stellenbosch University between Pinot Noir and Hermitage, now called Cinsault.

This uniquely South African grape has traditionally been grown in hotter regions of the Cape, however it has found its stride on our cool, south facing slopes. Our unique terroir brings out the subtlety and delicate characteristics of its Pinot Noir parentage. We have created four unique expressions of Pinotage spanning the full colour spectrum of wine.

Pinotage Rose 2022 Bottle R 145 / Glass R 45

A delicious summer drink with strawberries and cream jumping out of the glass, well integrated acidity and a pale pink hue. Enjoy with salads, fresh fish or on its own.

Pinotage 2021 Bottle R 145 / Glass R 45

Our Veldfire Pinotage expresses its Pinot noir parentage beautifully. It is lively and smooth on the palate with delicate red fruit coming through on the nose; raspberries, cherries and strawberry are all prominent while still maintaining fine structure and balance.

Cape Blend 2021 Bottle R 145 / Glass R 45

A cool climate blend of 75% Shiraz and 25% Pinotage. This is a robust wine with great balance between savoury and fruit flavours. Good spice and weight from the Syrah complimented by fresh, red fruit from the Pinotage. Enjoy with a wide range of dishes or on its own. Dark berries, liquorice and olives give this wine a broody nature while the tannins are still soft and elegant.

Stanford Hills MCC 2017 R400

This Méthode Cap Classique from the exceptional 2017 vintage has spent four years on the lees before disgorgement. The extended time on the lees provides a well-rounded, creamy mouth feel with mouth-watering minerality, perfect balance and a seamless finish. Pale gold with delicate bubbles and enticing lemon cream and almond Biscotti precede lovely layers of citrus and a finish with appealing length and freshness.
