## What is a cigar ring gauge?

The ring gauge of a cigar goes hand-in-hand with its length since size drives a key component of style, construction, and burning experience. For illustration purposes, a 'ring' is equivalent to 1/64 of an inch in diameter – a 50-ring cigar equals 50/64 of an inch. While there are no set rules to the thickness of a cigar, there are industry standards most manufacturers follow, catering to the demands of the marketplace.

In the past, ring gauge was a product of Cuban cigar manufacturers' tribal knowledge. Most cigars were small in size: Petit Coronas and Lanceros were preferred among most consumers. Believe it or not, many years ago a 50-ring Rothschild was considered huge! However current production is largely driven by the American cigar consumer, which demands ever more variety in both thickness and length, making 50-ring vitolas commonplace. In fact, today we regularly see cigars boasting thick 58 and 60-ring frames and beyond.

We even see special figurados and "artisan" style cigars, such as Perfectos and Salomons which contain several different thicknesses throughout the 'barrel' of the cigar. These are extremely difficult to roll but deliver a unique concentration of flavour to the palate.

## Cigar shapes

A cigar shape can vary greatly in size from brand to brand, so describing a cigar by its size as well as shape is important.





## **Ever wonder how cigars get their ratings?**

Is a '92' rating cigar really that much better than a '88' rated cigar? Do people buy cigars based on their ratings?

The Cigar Aficionado Magazine is regarded as a world authority on cigar ratings, with their panel of experts using a set standard to judge a cigar. In the Cigar Aficionado Rating System, the following is a general rule of thumb:

- '90' or above signals something outstanding,
- anything '80' or above is very good to great,
- something in the 70's is fine to smoke, and
- anything below '70' isn't usually worth the bother.

The system reflected in our catalogue is based on the following criteria:

### **Appearance/Construction (15 points maximum)**

Turns out your mom was only half right. You can't judge a book by its cover, but you can usually tell if it's something to be taken seriously or something cheaper designed for an afternoon on the beach. The 15-point rating here advocates that a cigar should have a smooth wrapper with no discernible flaws and a consistent colour and shape to earn maximum appearance points. To judge construction, hold it like you're about to take a puff. It should feel firm but not absolutely rigid, and give you a slight oily sensation. If it's dry and flaky, that's a sign the cigar has seen better days.

### **Smoking characteristics (25 points maximum)**

This covers how well the cigar smokes, from the moment it's lit until you've taken that last draw. You want the cigar to light easily and burn evenly, and to feel comfortable in your mouth. If the cigar has too hard of a draw, if it doesn't burn evenly, or if it does anything else that makes it difficult to enjoy, points are deducted here.

### **Flavour (25 points maximum)**

For a cigar to score high in the flavour category, it should have a smooth and rich taste that is consistently good throughout the smoke. The flavour itself may change over the course of the smoke, and some of the best ones do, but the quality should always be high. If it tastes bitter, take points away.

### **Overall impression (35 points maximum)**

Simply put... how was it? Was it a great cigar smoking experience, or something less than you expected?
