CHENIN BLANC

DRY WHITE

Wine: Darling Cellars Reserved Arum Fields Chenin Blanc

A very restraint and shy wine this early in the year.

With decanting, guava, complimented with passion fruit; peach blossoms and citrus, dominate the nose.

This lightly wood fermented Bush Vine Chenin Blanc was kept on fine lees for almost 3 months. A well rounded Chenin with a crisp fresh finish that will grow complex with bottle.

Grootte Post is situated on the southern slopes of Darling hills, 5km from the Atlantic and 64km from Cape Town.

Grootte Post is one of the oldest farms on the West Coast. It was the Dutch East guardstations. The farm host two national monuments dating back to the 18th century.

The farm is owned and run by the Pentz family since 1957 they stand proud with some of the best and prize winning wines namely Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, Merlot and Shiraz in the West Coast.

Their winemaker is Lukas Wentzel a former assistant winemaker at La Motte wine estate. He also completed 5 vintages at Grootte Post. Their aim is to produce world-class wines giving attention to every detail from vineyards through to marketing. Their wines 70% of their wines are sold in the RSA and 30% are exported.



CHARDONNAY

Wine: Darling Cellars Quercus Gold Chardonnay

White pears and tropical fruit are the flavours you'll find on this lightly wooded Chardonnay. An elegant wine with or without food.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Wine: Darling Cellars Bush Vine Sauvignon Blanc

Typical tropical flavours on the nose with passion fruit and guava dominating. These flavours together with hints of gassiness are carried through generously to the palate with a zesty long aftertaste.

Wine: Riebeek Sauvignon Blanc

A well defined barbeque style white wine. Tropical understones of gooseberries add fruitiness to the palate while well balanced acids ensure a fresh and crisp easy drinking wine.

Geelbek Winecellar

Henry de Villiers Steytler, the Governor General, had the lagoon dredged to allow boats to come closer to the homestead for his famous parties which lasted for weeks. In 1920 Steytlers winecellar here at Geelbek was reputed to be the largest in South Africa. This was not because of wine production, but of the quantity of wine on hand for social occasions. Although there is nothing left of the old winecellar, Geelbek is still the best place to enjoy a glass of the regions wine and beautiful sunsets.



DRY ROSE

Wine: Riebeek Pinotage Rose

This elegant wine offers flavour in abundance without cloying sweetness. The flavours are distinctive of fresh strawberries and ripe cherries

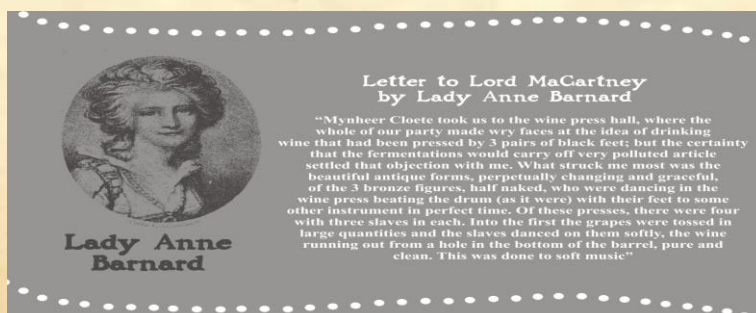
Delicate red, crisp, light, lively, exuberant and refreshing sparkling wine.
