Trencher |'tren(t)SHər| noun

1 *historical* a wooden plate or platter for food.

• a slice of bread used as a plate or platter.

Middle English: from Anglo-Norman French *trenchour*, from Old French *trenchier* 'to cut'

Slow roasted to perfection, either on the spit or in the oven, the roast of the day is served on a trencher platter with rosemary and cracked salt potato wedges, a selection of veggies, Yorkshire pudding, and a pan gravy.

pub |pʌb| British

origin mid 19th century: abbreviation of public house

Bangers and Mash 102

Pork sausages cooked with garlic, onions, mushrooms, wine and honey, with a potato mash, and chilli jam.

Fish 'n Chips 98

Crispy, pale ale craft beer battered, seasoned fillet of Cape hake, deep fried and served with chips, mushy peas and tartare sauce.

Steak and Ale Pie 112

House made steak, ale and mushroom pot pie under a pastry crust. Served with mash potato.

Porchetta Pulled Pork Roll 102

Slow roasted porchetta style pork topped with coleslaw, on freshly baked roll, served with chips

Chicken and Chips 108

Half chicken locally raised, brined for 12 hours and dry rubbed in a house blend of spices, served with chips.

Vegetable Lasagne 89

Roasted seasonal vegetables in a hearty, cheese bake. Served with a side salad. ✓

Selection of cheeses, ham, roast beef, pickles, chutney, mustard, and a Manchet bread loaf.
