### **Edgebaston David Finlayson**

**R260**

Ripe, fresh raspberry, strawberry and vanilla notes on the nose. The palate has a touch of minerality and earthiness layered below the fresh, clean fruit.

## *Pinotage*

### **Ken Forrester Petit**

**R124**

Aromas of spicy mulberries, plum pudding and cherries. Juicy and accessible with soft palate and delicious fruit concentration.

### **Beyerskloof**

**R144**

Full bodied and complex. The blackberry cassis flavours are well balanced with the subtle wood maturation character.

### **Diemersfontein**

**R206**

Dark chocolate with a hint of mint and baked plums on the nose.

### **Lanzerac**

**R180**

Ripe berries and plums on the nose and palate with a good mouth-feel and lingering aftertaste. It is a full-bodied, complex wine with a beautiful fruit/wood balance.
