149 – Delicious & Uncomplicated Wines

Quando Mourvèdre Rose 2021 - Fanus Bruwer, Robertson



The vines are rooted on the slopes of red karoo clay of the Robertson Valley enhancing the flavours of the red berries. Only the first Cuvee free run juice was used to make this wine resulting in a Rose with onion skin colour, tones of red berries on the nose following through with a crispy palate.

M.A.N Family Wines Chenin Blanc 2020 - Riaan Moller, Coastal Region

91/49

Chenin Blanc thrives in warm climate, deep soils and bush-vine vineyards. Only the free run juice to preserve its clean, natural character, refreshing acidity and delicious ripe fruit flavours.

M.A.N Family Wines Skaapveld Shiraz 2019 - Riaan Moller, Coastal Region

Skaapveld refers to grazing land for sheep that adjoins many of the Syrah vineyards in the region. Some say the presence of the sheep influences the wine.

Groote Post Old Mans Red Blend 2020 - Lukas Wentzel, Darling
Merlot|Cabernet Sauvignon|Shiraz

The Old Man's Blend Red 2020 vintage is an ever so approachable wine, with ruby red colour. On the nose ripe red fruit with raspberry and fresh cherry on the palate. Long and smooth finish rounds off this everyday drinking red.

South Hill Sauvignon Blanc 2021 - Sean Skibbe, Elgin Valley



Exclusively made from grapes grown in the cool, rolling hills of the Elgin area. Minimalist winemaking ensures their wines are as distinctive as the unique terroir. Dry, fresh tropical flavours, versatile food partner. *Integrity and sustainability certified*

Robert Alexander Merlot 2019 - Nico van der Merwe, Stellenbosch

Selected grapes from specially identified low yielding vineyards were vivified according to traditional methods. Serious yet friendly wine, ideal with red meat.

Doolhof Dark Lady Pinotage 2019 - Gielie Beukes, Wellington

Rich Pinotage echoes dark crimson berry flavours, overlaid by a beguiling dark chocolate tone.

Remhoogte Chenin Blanc 2021 - Chris Boustred, Stellenbosch

Aromas of floral violets and honeysuckle. Bright juicy citrus fruit with a limey acid bringing freshness. A mild salinity on the finish gives great length.

Sophie Te'Blanche 2021 - Werner Muller, Elgin



Vibrant pure fruit of cut green apples, zesty limes, gooseberries and tropical notes with white flowers and subtle mineral undertones.

Sophie Le Rouge 2020 - Werner Muller, Elgin

Red fruit aromas with subtle notes of cassis and spice. The palate is intense and concentrated with ripe and seamless tannins.

Doolhof Lady in White Chenin Blanc 2018 - Gielie Beukes, Wellington

A complex, crisp and lively dry white Chenin Blanc. Subtle, elegant citrus with fresh lemon and lime to the fore. Soft, crisp, lengthy finish with hints of oak.

Rickety Bridge Chardonnay 2018 - Donovan Ackermann, Franschoek

Vines growing in granite slopes are hand-picked early morning. This elegant Chardonnay shows notes of fresh citrus, orange blossom and nutty nuances with a rich and structured palate which has a fresh minerality that lingers on the long creamy finish.

Gabrielskloof Syrah 2018 - Peter-Allen Finlayson, Bot River

The Syrah is naturally fermented and aged in older barrels for 18 months. Minimal intervention winemaking philosophy, only taking action where absolutely necessary reflecting the terroir of the vineyard.

Gabrielskloof The Blend (Bordeaux) 2019 - Peter-Allen Finlayson, Bot River

Minimal intervention winemaking philosophy, only taking action where absolutely necessary reflecting the terroir of the vineyard.

Groote Post Unwooded Chardonnay 2020 - Lukas Wentzel, Darling

Orange blossom and stone fruit are prominent on the nose. Steely minerality with lingering citrus fruit on the palate makes this wine your perfect summer companion.

South Hill Cabernet Sauvignon 2019 - Sean Skibbe, Elgin Valley



Exclusively made from grapes grown in the cool, rolling hills of the Elgin area. Minimalist winemaking ensures our wines are as distinctive as this unique terroir. Medium bodied, juicy cherry & blackcurrant flavours.

270 – Different & Daring Wines

Groote Post Sea Salter Sauvignon Blanc 2021 - Lukas Wentzel, Darling
Sauvignon Blanc|Semillon.

Wonderfully expressive on the nose and palate with captivating notes of black current, stone fruit and green apple together with hints of fynbos and kelp, sea-breeze and a touch of oak. An elegant well-balanced wine showing typical Darling minerality, vibrant acidity and some leesy complexity before a saline finish.

Springfield Whole Berry Cabernet Sauvignon 2019 - Abrie Bruwer, Robertson

De-stemmed, whole uncrushed bunches are transported using only a gravity flow system. Whole berry maceration is followed by fermentation with natural yeasts, racking and one year's maturation in oak barrels. The result is a velvety wine with softer tannins and classical varietal characteristics, achieving a luscious, juicy wine.

Lievländ Bushvine Pinotage 2019 - Riaan Moller, Klapmuts/Stellenbosch



A modern, elegant style of Pinotage with vibrant aromas of cherry and raspberries and a hint of cedar and vanilla from the oak maturation. The palate shows ample red fruit and a delicious savoury note. Dry-farmed bushvine vineyards lends a depth and richness and add delicious complexity to this wine.

An elegant refreshing Cap Classique displaying a vibrant pale gold colour, a fine creamy mousse, zesty notes of green apple and white pear with hints of brioche, a well-rounded velvety yet lively mouthfeel and a crisp lingering finish.

Arendsig Chardonnay 2019 - Lourens van der Westhuizen, Robertson/Bonnievale



Arendsig wines are a selection of single vineyard wines from unique soil, climate and location. These single vineyard wines are made with minimal interference throughout the vinification. Fermentation happens spontaneously and maturation takes place in neutral vessels to bring through the unique vineyard character.

Soil: Weathered Karoo Shale. Integrity and sustainability certified

Nicolas Red Blend 2017 - Nico van der Merwe, Stellenbosch
Merlot|Cabernet Sauvignon|Cabernet Franc

This elegant wine with a distinct bouquet and flavour of ripe berries, dark chocolate and cedar will gain in complexity with further maturation. This wine partners well with red meats. Minimal interference and matured for 18 months in French Oak barrels

Kleinood Tamboerskloof Syrah 2017 - Reynie Oosthuizen, Stellenbosch



A bright ruby colour. Complex fruit develop into cranberry and blackberry, exquisitely opening the violets and jasmine notes. The entry is elegant with well-rounded tannin and the fruitful follow-through from nose causing the finish to linger.

Doolhof Single Vineyard Malbec 2018 - Gielie Beukes, Wellington



A rich, deep, voluptuous Malbec from the Cape Winelands. Intense garnet to dark purple in colour with vibrant aromas of violets, cocoa and black pepper. The palate shows richness and roundness with flavours of blackberries and plum.

Nicolas White Blend 2017 - Nico van der Merwe, Stellenbosch
Sauvignon Blanc|Semillon

Crisp blend with a complex mouthfeel and long fruity finish, will complement any light to medium cuisine like salads, chicken and fish dishes.
