Meerendal Merlot | 485

Deep crimson colour and shows rich concentrated flavours of dark chocolate, cherries and almonds.

Region: Durbanville

The Ahrens Family Bottelary

Seventy | 585

Cabernet brings backbone and Cinsault juiciness. A herbaceous nose, which reveals ripe blackcurrants and an umami savoury quality.

Anthonij Rupert Cabernet

Franc | 1100

A succulent entry with oodles of spicy blackberry fruit, cocoa and cinnamon spice with a light brush of herbs.

David Finlayson GS Cabernet

Sauvignon | 825

Named after wine legend George Spies, this is a huge wine with herbacious, minty fruit crammed into a dense tannic frame.

Morgenster Reserve | 950

The dense, complex mouth feel identifies an elegant balance between the classic oak tannins and equality between fresh ripe berry flavours and ripe integrated varietal tannins.

Bouchard Finlayson Galpin Peak

Pinot Noir | 610

Peppery spice with blackberry and cherry notes, ending in a harmonious and long earthy finish.

Vriesenhof Kallista | 750

Young and lively with compact fruit. Powerful acidity with dried fruit flavours with little regard from the oak.

Vintage: 2003

Kanonkop Pinotage | 910

Full bodied, deep ruby colour, ripe grape tannins and gentle oak flavours. A complex wine.

Vintage: 2006

Hartenberg Shiraz | 625

Voluptuous wine with displays of rich concentrated spice, pluminess and savouriness with big, but subtle, tannins.

Vilafonté Series M | 925

Malbec provides its black fruit aromas and fleshy texture. Merlot adds softness and red fruit aromas and Cabernet Sauvignon provides structure.

Vergelegen V | 1800

The nose is complex, showing blackcurrants, red cherries, cedar wood, lead pencil and cigar box aromas. These develop in the glass and are joined by raspberry, black cherry, spice and a hint of gaminess.
