Sparkling

Hermanuspietersfontein Maria Elisabet 260
Comprising of all three noble Champagne cultivars in Pinot noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier, crisp and elegant with a creamy freshness.

Whites

House White 100 / 30

Beaumont Chenin Blanc 175
Cooler climate Chenin Blanc fermented in concrete and stainless steel tanks. Dry, fresh and delicious.

Whalehaven Chenin Viognier 165
Aromas of green melon and orange blossom, this unwooded blend has notes of guava, pear and pineapple

First Sighting Sauvignon Blanc 155
Tropical and citrus fruit on the nose. Full and fresh on the palate with notes of buchu and minerality.

Hermanuspietersfontein Kaalvoet meisie 170
White blossom and fynbos aromas, crisp freshness with European minerality.

Moya's Vineyards Sauvignon Blanc 145
An elegant maritime driven wine, abounds with both tropical and green spectrums of aromas, green peppers, winter melon, asparagus and citrus.

Newton Johnson Southend Chardonnay 220
Strikingly expressive ripe citrus and mineral character. Elegant and concentrated, discreet oaking which complements with spice and a nuttiness.

Felicite Unwooded Chardonnay 140 / 35
Green tinged pale straw. Slightly tropical, ripe quince aromas, faint pear drop and grapefruit hints.

Ashbourne Sauvignon Chardonnay 160

Fresh, vibrant, perfumed Sauvignon blanc, filled-out and enriched with a unwooded Chardonnay component, beautifully balanced and a highly versatile wine. Made by the Hamilton Russell family.

Rose

Hermanuspietersfontein Bloos 160

A unique wine from five different Bordeaux varieties, an abundance of cherry, raspberry, mulberry and candyfloss flavours and a touch of French oak.

Gabrielskloof Rosebud 140 / 35

Strawberry and caramel, fresh palate cleansing mouthfeel.

Reds

Seven Springs Pinot Noir 230

A beautifully balanced, vibrant wine with delicate woodland and truffle undertones. Offering aromas of raspberries, cherries and strawberries, the oak is subtle, supporting the fruit driven profile of this wine.

Newton Johnson Pinot Noir 225

Berry fruit flavour classic to the Hemel-en-Aarde area, youthful acidity and grippy texture form respectively from the cool Atlantic-influenced climate and granite soil.

Barton Merlot 155

Subtle taste of blackberry, plums and a deep earthy flavour, soft ripe tannins with good underlying acidity.

Hornbill Pinotage 150 / 40

Nose has a hint of floral, chocolate and dark Amarillo cherry, structured tannins and acidity give good length and balance.

Gabrielskloof The Blend 165

Full, ripe red berry, followed by a welcoming tobacco with a hint of caramel, herbaceous flintiness with firm tannins.

Hermanuspietersfontein Posmeester

Black olive, clove, lavender and cashew characteristics, medium bodied with smooth tannins, generous length, and supple consistency.

Fortified and Late Harvest

De Krans Cape Ruby

Medium-bodied, youthful with fruity, spicy flavours and balanced sweetness.
